### TO QUALIFY FOR AN ARIZONA NOTARY PUBLIC COMMISSION AN APPLICANT

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must be a citizen or a legal permanent resident of the U.S.
- Must NOT have a conviction for a felony UNI FSS your
- Must be an Arizona Resident for income tax purposes.
- If you have had a professional license revoked or suspended for misconduct or dishonesty or any cause that substantially

civil rights have been restored, or a conviction of a lesser offense involving moral turpitude or of a nature that is incompatible with the duties of a notary public.  Must be able to read and write English.	relates to the duties or responsibilities of a notary public, or if you have had your notary commission revoked or suspended, the Secretary of State may refuse to grant you a commission.

Include your middle initial or middle name ONLY if you intend to use it when signing as a notary public.  ☐ Your signature in Section 5 must be an original signature in ink.  ☐ The typed name and signature on the application must also EXACTLY match the name on the bond that you obtain in Step 2 of these instructions.	Address Requirements:  ☐ Include the PHYSICAL location of your residence; you are commissioned from your home address.  ATTENTION: The Business Address is public record and will be displayed online at the Secretary of State's website.  Fill in all form blanks:  ☐ If a field is not applicable, respond with "n/a" unless a field is "required."

Name Requirements:  ☐ The bond must show the printed (Section 2) and signed (Section 5) name EXACTLY as prepared on the application.  Date & Time-Frame Requirements: ☐ The bond MUST include its effective and expiration dates. ☐ Effective Date: The bond cannot be issued MORE THAN 60 DAYS BEFORE the commission is initiated. ☐ Expiration date: The expiration date of the bond is always four years later and one day less than the effective date.	Signature Requirements:  ☐ Your signature must be properly notarized and sealed with an ink notary seal on the bond. Because the bond is a "jurat" there can't be any blank spaces.  ☐ The Notary who executes the bond cannot be the same person who is purchasing the bond.  ☐ The bond must be countersigned by the authorized bonding company agent in two places on the bond form.

Expedite processing varies with a 24-48 hour turnaround standard.     Applicants who request expedited service need to clearly mark the envelope as "EXPEDITE."     \$43.00 total filling fee (application and bond)     + \$25.00 expedited service request     = \$68.00 total filling fee
STEP 4. Obtain an Official Notary Seal	
WAIT to receive a commission certificate from the Secretary of State designating you as a notary. Once received:  ☐ Order a rubber notary seal (stamp) from a stationery store.	The rubber stamp <i>must</i> contain five items:  1. The words "NOTARY PUBLIC";  2. The name of the county in which you are commissioned:

- 4. Your current commission expiration date; and
